Professor Con Doolan leads the Flow Noise Group within the School of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering. He has held leadership positions in the Faculty of Engineering, such as Associate Dean (Academic Programs) and Deputy Head of School (Education) for the School of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering.

Professor Con Doolan has an honours degree in Mechanical Engineering and PhD in Aerospace Engineering from the University of Queensland. Previously, he was an Associate Professor, School of Mechanical Engineering at The University of Adelaide and has held positions at Defence Science & Technology Group, Australian Government Department of Defence, University of Glasgow.

Professor Doolan founded and leads the Flow Noise Group, a world leader in aeroacoustics, which is the science of sound produced by fluid flow. His research ranges from the fundamental to the applied, with extensive projects with the Australian Research Council and industries from Defence, medical mining, energy, aerospace, and construction sectors.

Professor Doolan has published over 300 research papers and is enthusiastically interested in the future of engineering education.
