

Professor Wai Fong Chua AM Independent Deputy Chair

Professor Wai Fong Chua AM teaches at the University of Sydney. Professor Chua holds a first-class honours degree in Accounting and Financial Management as well as PhD from the University of Sheffield. Professor Chua was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Jyvaskyla, Finland in 2009. She is additionally a Fellow of both Certified Practising Accountants Australia and Chartered Accountant Australia and New Zealand. In 2019 Professor Chua was inducted into the Australian Accounting Hall of Fame. She was admitted as a Fellow of the Academy of the Social Sciences in Australia in 2009 and served as the Academy's Treasurer from 2019-2023.

Professor Chua has extensive executive experience, having held senior positions in Australian higher educational institutions. Professor Chua is also internationally known for her research on accounting as social and organisational practice. She has had her research published in prestigious, international journals such as *Accounting, Organizations and Society, Contemporary Accounting Research and The Accounting Review*, and serves on numerous editorial boards. She was presented the Outstanding Contribution to the Accounting and Finance Research Literature Award by the Accounting and Finance Association of Australia and New Zealand in 2009.

In 2016 Professor Chua was appointed a Member of the Order of Australia where she was recognised for her outstanding contributions to research, mentoring and university administration.
